


### Party Identification of NH Adults







### Party Identification of NH Undeclared Voters


#### New Hampshire Gubernatorial Vote: 1980-2012







# Core Partisanship of NH Electorate: 2000 – 2012 UNH Survey Center polls








# Presidential approval and President's party losses in midterm elections (since WWII)



Presidential Approval at Time of Election %






### Shaheen Favorability Rating






### **GOP Net Favorability Ratings**










### Shea-Porter Favorability Rating: 1st CD






### Guinta Favorability Rating: 1st CD






# Innis Favorability Rating: 1st CD






### 1<sup>st</sup> CD: Shea-Porter v. Guinta Likely Voters






# Kuster Favorability Rating: 2<sup>nd</sup> CD






# Garcia Favorability Rating: 2<sup>nd</sup> CD






# Lambert Favorability Rating: 2<sup>nd</sup> CD




### 2<sup>nd</sup> CD: Kuster v. Garcia Likely Voters



#### Generic Ballot: NH Senate



### 2014 Elections
